Guidance and Conditions for International Travel Prize Applications

What is the purpose of the Prize?

The purpose of these Travel Prizes is to support the attendance of the student at an international scientific meeting of their choice during 2023, in the area of organic, biological or medicinal chemistry, through funding wholly, or in part, of registration, accommodation and travel costs.

Who is eligible?

Applications are welcomed from any post-graduate students currently enrolled in research programmes (PhD or Masters) in UK institutions. Successful applicants will be also expected to present their work, in either oral or poster form, at the meeting for which the Travel Prize has been awarded, or at another appropriate RSC/BMCS sponsored meeting.

How is the Prize awarded?

These Travel Prizes will be awarded on a competitive basis to students who complete the application process and are subsequently selected by the BMCS committee. successful applicants will be notified by **16th January 2023**, and Travel Prizes should be taken up in 2023. Acknowledgement of the RSC BMCS should be made in any presentation given.

What documentation is required in the application for a Travel Prize?

In addition to this application form, completed as per the instructions, applicants are required to provide **ALL** of the following: a two-page summary of research progress, highlighting key results and their individual contributions to the project; a supporting letter from their supervisor; a supporting letter from their head of department. These may be sent as separate documents or combined into a single document: either PDF or Microsoft Word documents are acceptable. Any applications not complete by the closing date will not be eligible for judging.

What type of expenditure can be funded?

Registration fee, accommodation costs, budget travel expenses.

Why do we ask for social media handles?

This would be used to promote the Travel Prize Programme and to publicise the prize winners through the various BMCS social media outlets

What is the maximum value of each Prize?

A number of International Travel Prizes will be awarded in 2022 of up to £2,000.

What is the closing date for applications?

16th December 2022

How should claims be submitted?

Successful Travel Prize Winners should submit their completed claim form with receipts to the Secretary of the BMCS within 30 days of the end of the conference.
